

we are pleased to announce that the 4th International Symposium on Superheavy Elements (SHE2019) will take place in Hakone, Japan from December 1st (evening) to 5th (morning), 2019. SHE2019 follows the previous symposiums at Texas A&M University, USA in 2013 and 2015, and Kazimierz Dolny, Poland in 2017. SHE2019 is jointly organized by the RIKEN Nishina Center, the Research Center for Superheavy Elements, Kyushu University, and the Advanced Science Research Center, Japan Atomic Energy Agency.







VENUE

SHE2019 will be held at The Prince Hakone Lake Ashinoko in Hakone, Japan. Hakone is close to Tokyo at the foot of Mount Fuji and is one of the most popular travel destinations among Japanese and foreign tourists. SCIENTIFIC PROGRAM

SHE2019 will cover all theoretical and experimental aspects of superheavy nuclei and atoms. The symposium will consist of invited talks, oral and poster sessions. The invited talks will be selected based on recommendations by the international advisory committee (IAC). The oral and poster contributions will be decided based on reviewed abstracts.

The scientific program will include the following topics:

- Reaction of synthesis of the heaviest and neutron-rich nuclei
- Nuclear structure and decay properties of the SH-nuclei
- Atomic (electronic) structure and chemical properties of SHE
- Heaviest nuclei in nucleosynthesis and search for SHE in nature
- New facilities and setups for SHE research
